- WHEREAS:** the CDBG program has considerable flexibility to allow communities to carry out activities that are tailored to their unique affordable housing and neighborhood revitalization needs, and
- WHEREAS:** the City of Fayetteville, with CDBG funds in the amount of \$16,041,849 since 1989, has provided Housing Rehabilitation, Redevelopment and Transportation Programs. In addition, CDBG funds have assisted many community nonprofits through the Subrecipient Grant Program,
