# Monthly Progress Highlights:

- In partnership with the City, continued to support the Fayetteville Small Business Resiliency Task Force (FSBRTF) as needed.
- Held COVID vaccine clinic in partnership with Community Clinic, in place of the Startup Crawl.
- Supported and participated in the City of Fayetteville Economic Recovery and Vitality Steering Committee planning work.
- Continued leading and supporting virtual events.
- Continued support of the City's Outdoor Refreshment Area (ORA) initiative. Critical to helping drive business to our local small businesses while helping mitigate the pandemic.
- Continued regular announcements relaying the latest federal and state aid updates for small businesses, and in doing so responded to hundreds of inquires from small businesses working with them on the mechanics and details of each.
